Again, fall dates are recommended for Seniors and Spring dates for Juniors, however both can be taken by either on any date.

The ACT website is act.org. They also provide free test prep programs. Again, if you are planning on taking the ACT now is a good time to open a free account with them as well.

It is strongly suggested that students take the SAT/ACT at least twice as scores tend to go up with practice.

What's the difference between SAT/ACT?

The SAT is a standardized test with a different format than the ACT. Most colleges will accept either test, students should check into what their college of choice prefers. Some students score higher on the ACT than the SAT (and viceversa). If feasible, juniors could take both to see which they prefer/score higher on. Seniors should take the fall and winter exams. Juniors may begin taking their 1st exam in the winter or they can wait until Spring.
