

# SAT and ACT Registration Info for Juniors and Seniors

## Test Dates 2020

Both SAT and ACT registration takes place online. (The ACT is not offered at OCS but in Puebla) If you need more info about these exams, please visit the websites posted below. Your student will need to create a Collegeboard student account or ACT account if they've not done so already. This is where they will register for the exam, practice, and receive score results amongst other information.

SAT practice booklets will be handed out to the Jr. and Srs. this fall. Khan Academy online also has free SAT practice available.

It is strongly suggested that students take the SAT/ACT at least twice as scores tend to go up with practice. Seniors should take the fall and winter exams. Juniors may begin taking their 1<sup>st</sup> exam in the winter or they can wait until Spring.

## SAT

We have 3 SAT test dates at OCS. These are the Fall and Spring dates for 2020.

### Spring Test Date

Sat. May 2nd

### Registration Deadline

April 3<sup>rd</sup> (1 month before test date)

### Fall Test Dates

Sat. Oct. 3rd

Sat. Dec. 5th

### Registration Deadline

Sept 2nd (1 month before test date)

Nov 4th (1 month before test date)

Fall dates are recommended for Seniors and Spring dates for Juniors, however both can be taken by either on any date.

SAT scores can be sent to colleges for FREE, upon registering the SAT, any date before the test date and up to nine days afterwards through their collegeboard accounts. After which there is a \$12 fee to send scores to colleges.

## Non-US Test Dates

February 7-8, 2020

Register by 17 January 2020 (or 31 January + late fee)

April 3-4, 2020

Register by 13 March 2020 (or 27 March + late fee)

June 12-13, 2020

Register by 22 May 2020 (or 5 June + late fee)

FALL TEST DATES TO BE ANNOUNCED

Again, fall dates are recommended for Seniors and Spring dates for Juniors, however both can be taken by either on any date.

The ACT website is [act.org](http://act.org). They also provide free test prep programs. Again, if you are planning on taking the ACT now is a good time to open a free account with them as well.

## **What's the difference between SAT/ACT?**

The SAT is a standardized test with a different format than the ACT. Most colleges will accept either test, students should check into what their college of choice prefers. Some students score higher on the ACT than the SAT (and viceversa). If feasible, juniors could take both to see which they prefer/score higher on.
